## **X** Marriage and Divorce Records

The chart below indicates when statewide and county marriage and divorce record-keeping officially began in each state—that's when counties started to collect marriage and divorce information and possibly report it to state offices. Some counties or towns kept statistics earlier, and some were slow to comply with state laws, so check with ancestors' local government for record availability.

*Note:* **Most states maintain marriage and divorce records at the county level**. Even though counties were mandated to keep records, early records are often sporadic and/or unavailable. Many states have marriage/divorce index only despite indications to the contrary. Marriage licenses had to be returned to the issuer by the officiant in order to be legally recorded. Such licenses, issued by the county were valid for the entire state.
